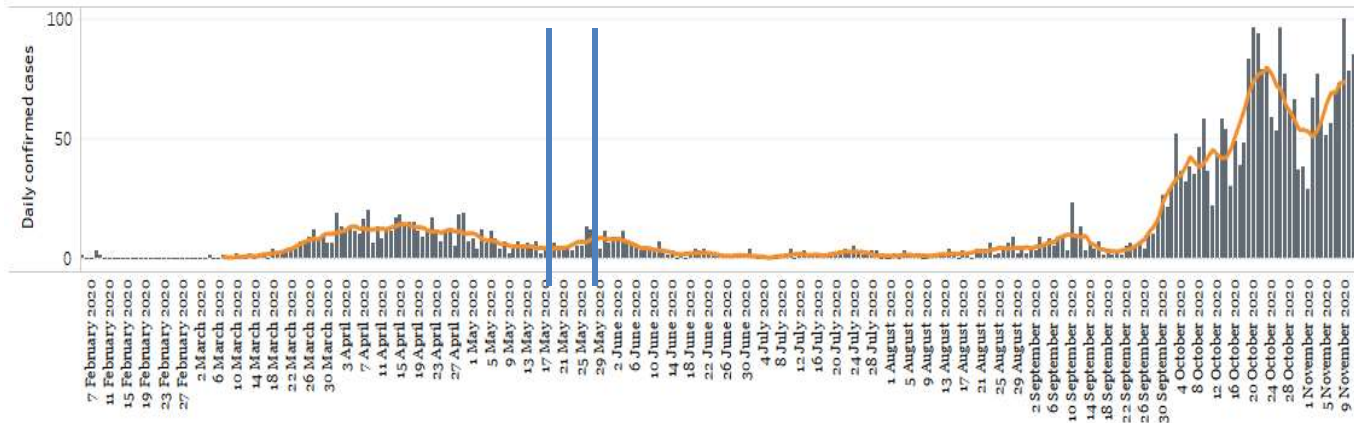

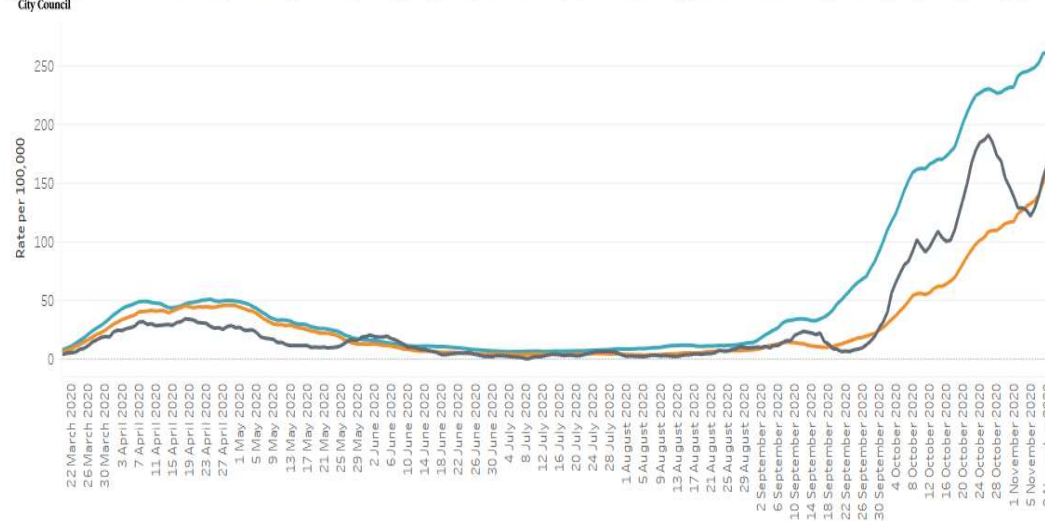


Confirmed case rate

- In the 7 days up to the 11 November there were 176 cases per 100,000 people – an increase of 38% compared to the 7 days up to the 4 November (128 cases per 100,000)
- Equivalent rate in England is 271 per 100,000 and for the South East 171 per 100,000

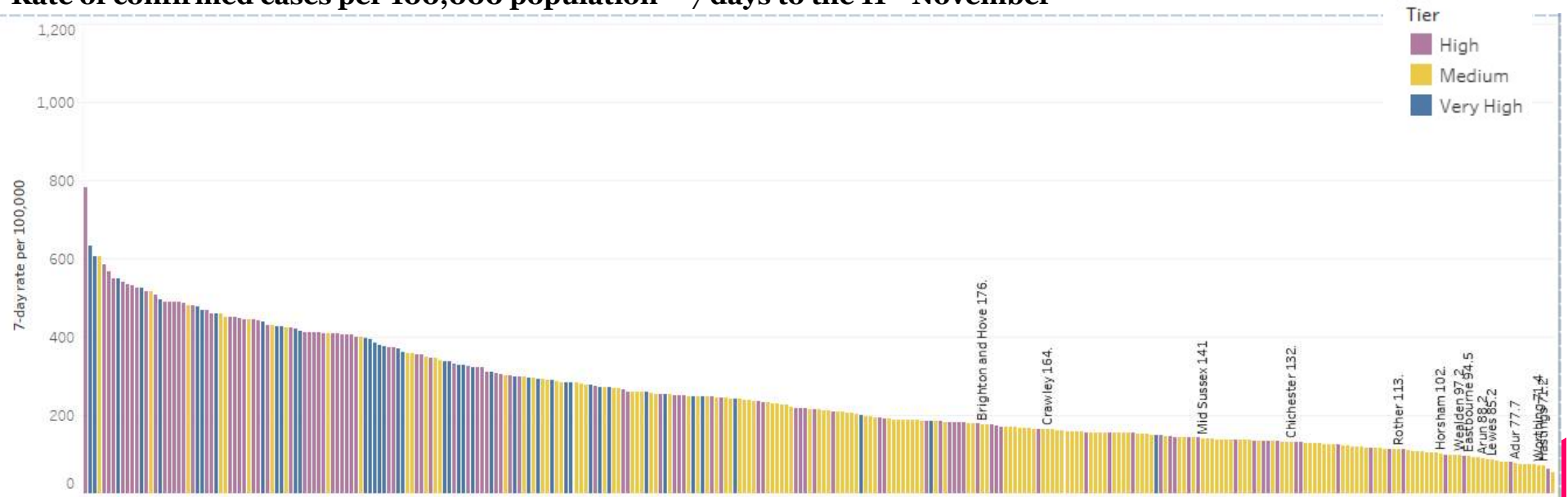


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Case rates: national comparison

Rate of confirmed cases per 100,000 population – 7 days to the 11th November

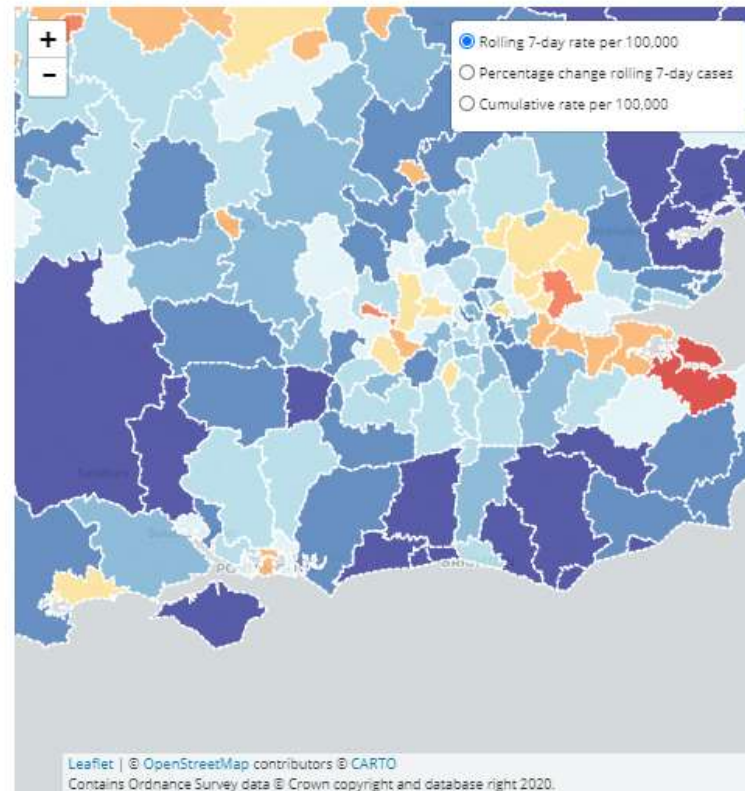


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Position across England (7 days to 11 November)

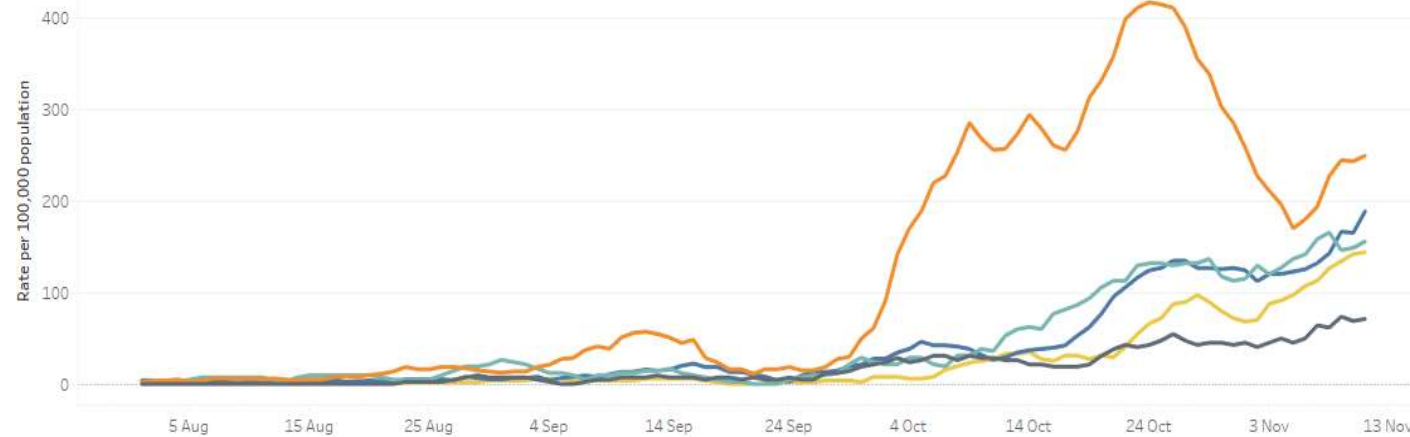

Confirmed COVID-19 cases per 100,000 in Brighton & Hove in 7 days up to 11 November 2020, by age group:

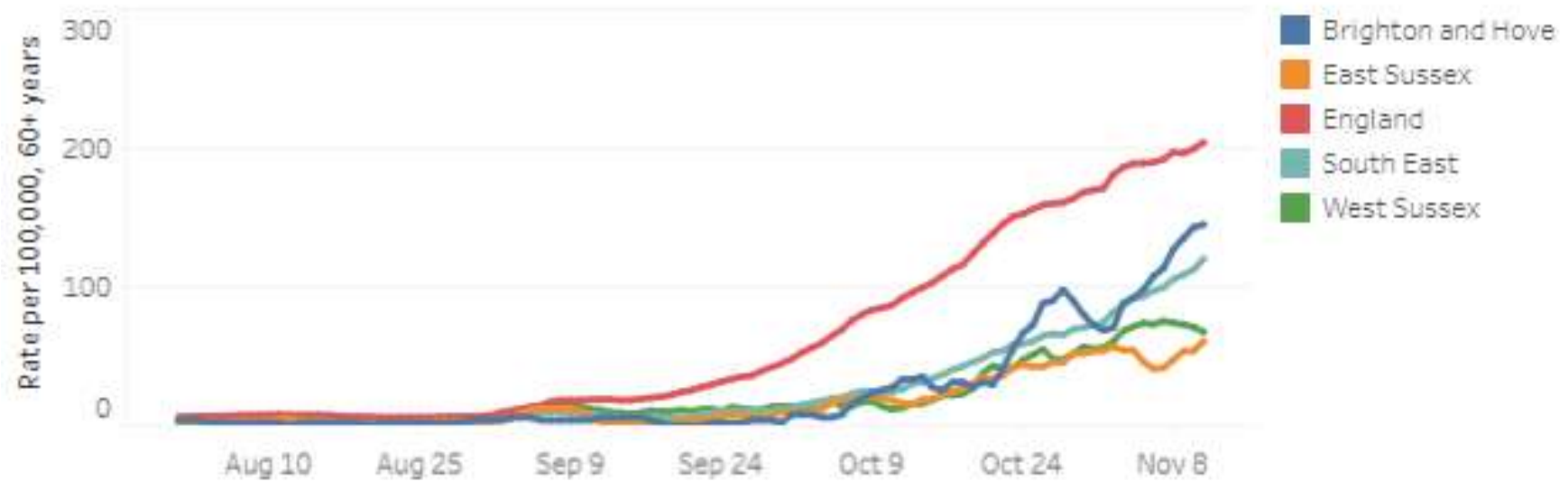
0-14 years	71.3
15-29 years	250.0
30-39 years	156.2
40-59 years	189.3
60+ years	144.3

- Increases in the last week in all age groups:
- 0-14yrs from 50 to 71 per 100,000 (42%↑)
- 15-29 from 197 to 250 (27%↑)
- 30-39 from 127 to 156 (23%↑)
- 50-59 from 121 to 189 (56%↑)
- 60+yrs from 92 to 144 (57%↑)



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Age: 7 day case rate in aged 60 and over

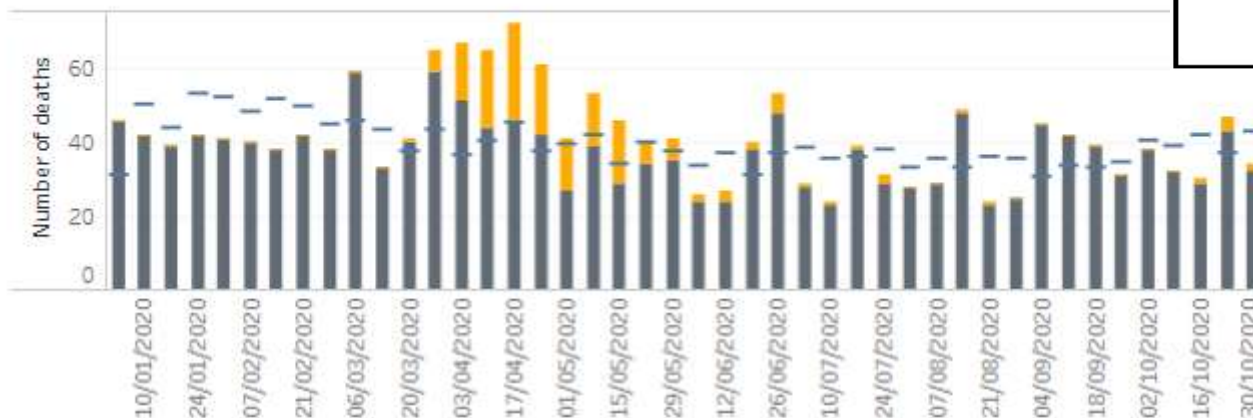
