We thought you would like to know a little more about our marvellous youth team and have a snapshot of the variety of youth work we cover. They put on regular weekly activities as well as a holiday programme most holidays. They work with young people from the age of 8 up to 25 and all our Youth Team is part time. We also have a 'Young Leaders' programme where training is given so that young people can volunteer to help with activities and give peer to peer support, and they work towards the Gold Youth Award. The team also work with many partners across the city including local schools, the police, the Youth Collective and Allsorts.



Michelle our senior Youth Worker joined the project in 2007, she is currently on maternity leave and we want to say congratulations on the birth of beautiful baby Meadow.

Helen joined in 2006, she heads up our participation with the Youth Manifesto Group <http://www.hkym.co.uk> and the weekly Knoll Drop-in, she is currently managing the team in Michelle's absence.

Nina joined in 2007; she is in charge of the young leaders programme, our sexual health work and has started a new project with our young multi-cultural residents and their families.

Polly joined in 2011; she leads our work with the young women's group (recently featured on Children in Need) our young men's group and our work in local schools.

All our youth workers are involved in our detached work, taking youth work to the young people out on the streets, making contact & giving help and support where needed. Finally of course the brilliant holiday programmes put together in consultation with the young people.
